With mercury soaring to level this summer, we all are watchful about how to keep our interiors cool and more importantly environment friendly. One way is to bring nature closer to your home. Devika Khosla, creative director, The Works Interiors, says, "The current climate change and global warming warrant a pressing need to act, and act now. While big changes take lots of investment and planning, change begins at home; literally. We can start making small alterations to how we live, replace our older practices with ecologically sustainable ones and bring about a notable change in the longer run."

Khosla outlines some ways to give an environmentally friendly touch to your homes are:

Light it up naturally
Bring in natural light by giving larger windows as it will help reduce electricity consumption during the day. "If a space receives harsh sunlight, ensure that the glasses are double-glazed with well-packed frames to minimise air leaks and keep the space warmer in colder seasons," Khosla adds.

Sustainable products
Opt for low VOC (Volatile Organic Compound) products such as paints with low odour, water-based stains and finishes for furniture. These will reduce the environmental impact.

Source Ethically
Use furniture made from natural wood, especially wood that is sourced from plantation timber. These will save the natural forests from being taken down to meet the timber needs of the construction industry. Use locally sourced materials to boost the local economy.

Recyclable upholstery
Natural textiles and furnishings such as linens, cotton and silk are excellent materials for their aesthetics, biodegradable properties, and recyclable tendencies to be used as upholstery for cushions, curtains and furniture.

Rahul Mistri, principal designer at Open Atelier Mumbai, says, "Environmentally apperceptive solutions can be applied in all fundamental living factors and lifestyle elements through design. Breaking from the conventional myth of introducing planters is the only way to install green design within homes, one can opt

for a variety of ideas to obtain sustainable interior solutions for a home. Opting for organic and fast-growing materials like bamboo, rattan, etc can be a responsible choice for developing mood-boards. Exposed surfaces like mud tiles, rammed earth bricks, and other naturally produced and composed materials can reduce the carbon footprint of a home."

Automation systems that offer highly efficient and user savvy technology can save water, light, electricity and eventually energy within residential settings. "Lighting systems, heat insulation coatings for windows, and air ducts are alternative ways of reducing heat surroundings and hence impacting on the consumption of air conditioning," Mistri adds.

An overall perspective towards conscious green design practice from the stage of planning can result in a sustainable, economical and aesthetic home.

Rachna Agarwal, founder and design ideator, Studio IAAD, avers, "Climate change is no more a passive issue, as the stark evidence builds up each day, with the happenings around the world. Sustainability is no more a choice, but a necessity. One can adopt an eco-friendly approach at an individual level, starting from one's home."

Here are a few simple steps to help you build a sustainable home.

Your luminaire choices
Ample natural light is a must for any space, owing to its positive impacts on the health and wellbeing of the user. Though, choosing artificial lighting sources mindfully is just as significant. LEDs coupled with automation can single-handedly bring down your energy consumption.

"Reuse, reduce, and recycle your furniture One can make a conscious effort to reuse old furniture pieces by upscaling them creative-



ly or buying furniture made of eco-friendly materials like bamboo, rattan, or salvaged wood," Agarwal avers.

Maximise biophilia
One must introduce a myriad of lush greens, peppered around nooks and corners, balconies and living rooms of their homes, as they help establish the human connection with nature whilst purifying air.

Source art locally
Art breathes life into a space by adding a splash of colour and is a significant part of space-making. Buying art from a local artist or a craftsman not only ensures your role in reducing the carbon footprint but also contextualises your spaces with local themes, tones, and hues.

Choose water-efficient faucets Water is one of the most essential non-renewable re-

sources and one way to preserve it is to make mindful use of it by gifting our homes with a range of water-efficient faucets, that reduce the usage of water greatly.
